- 1.2 CAQM vide its email dated 31.01.2023, cited discussions of CoTS meeting of 22.11.22 and requested to revisit the decision to defer the agenda item "Matter related to "Policy to Curb Air Pollution in the National Capital Region", of the 71st Planning Committee meeting and requested that NCRPB may coordinate with NCR States for targeted actions, in the overall interest of abatement of Air pollution through effective integration of cleaner public transport system across the NCR.

MINUTES OF THE 71st MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE HELD ON 04.01.2023 AT 11.30 A.M. IN JACARANDA-I HALL, INDIA HABITAT CENTRE, LODHI ROAD, NEW DELHI

- Chairperson welcomed the members and participants to the Planning Committee meeting. List
 of participants is at Annexure-I. After a brief round of introduction, DD(Tech-AS), NCRPB
 initiated agenda wise discussions through a short presentation. Item wise details and decisions
 are as under:
- Agenda Item No. 71/1: Confirmation of the Minutes of 70th Planning Committee Meeting of the Board held on 20.09.2021
- 2.1 Planning Committee noted the status and thereafter Minutes of the 70th Meeting of the Planning Committee were confirmed.
- Agenda Item No. 71/2: Action taken on the decisions of the 70th meeting of Planning Committee
- 3.1 The Committee noted the action taken and status on various items listed under the agenda as mentioned in the circulated Agenda notes.

Decision:

State were again requested to expedite further action accordingly on those items.

(Action: NCR States & respective Cells)

- Agenda Item No. 71/3: NCR Planning and Monitoring Cell (NCRP&MC): Review of Staff status and work plans
- 4.1 The Committee noted the status Staff status and work plans of all the NCR Cells, as provided in the Agenda Notes.
- 4.2 Additional Secretary(H & D), MoHUA, GoI suggested that States should explore possibilities of strengthening the respective NCR Planning and Monitoring Cells through technologies instead of only focusing on manpower an staffing. He emphasized that at least 30% of the NCRPMC staff should be Planners, and requested NCRPB to consider such requests or proposed amendments in staff structure of Cells by the states. DG, T&CP, Haryana mentioned that the NCR Cell, Haryana is involved in purely planning work and accordingly, he has deputed 8 town planners specifically for this job. He requested Chairperson to sanction a post of Senior Town Planner in the NCR Cell, Haryana and also requested to approve the continuation of NCR Cell, Haryana upto 31.03.2025 as requisite parameters are already met by State Government, Haryana.
- 4.3 AS(H&D) further added that the plan implementation and monitoring should be carried out digitally and the related information should be updated regularly or possibly in real time basis on departmental portals/websites. Based on inputs provided by DG, T&CP, Haryana regarding digital mapping initiative and DD(Tech-GIS-NJ), NCRPB on NCR Geo Portal, developed by NCRPB with NIC support AS(H&D) recommended that related officers should sit together to device software based solutions for dynamic updation and refinement of geo spatial data on the portal, along with NIC team and ensure correct and updated information is available on public domain. DG, T&CP, Haryana also made clear that the State Government has policy on data sharing and it is seen that if the State Government is sharing the data to the other Government entity, then there should be reciprocal arrangement. DG, T&CP, Haryana categorically mentioned that the data related to Development Plan, Controlled Area etc. is under his control and they have taken adequate steps for protecting the said data.

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4.4 States assured towards working on suggestions given by AS(H&D), regarding staff restructuring and having more planning officers, and requested to consider extension of NCR P&M Cells till March 2025. Director (A&F) assured to look in to the proposals on staff once formally received. He clarified that matter of extension of NCR P & M Cells is taken at the Board level, and to address the concern of States on the matter, the proposal to authorize Member Secretary, NCRPB, for extension of NCR Cells, is being proposed to be taken up to the Board.

Decision:

After deliberations, the committee approved the proposal made in the Agenda notes.

- i. Data regarding respective sub regions should be exclusively under control of NCR Cells so that nobody else can tamper with it and data security be ensured by all NCRPMC's.
- ii. Further, Planning Committee recommended Board:
 - a. to consider extension for NCR Cells up to June 2023 subject to filling up of 50% vacant posts existing at the time of 40th Board meeting and thereafter Member Secretary may be authorized for extension of NCR Cells till 31.03.2025. However, State Government of Haryana has already complied with the directions of the 40th Board meeting regarding filling up of 50% of vacant posts, hence, the extension for NCR Cell, Haryana is recommended 'in-principle' upto 31.03.2025.
 - b. Member Secretary, NCRPB may be authorized to take any administrative and financial decision for smooth and efficient functioning of the NCR P&M Cells in future.

(Action: NCRPB; NCR States & Cells)

5. Agenda Item No. 71/4: Draft Regional Plan-2041 for NCR

5.1 The Committee noted the status presented on the agenda item. DG, T&CP, Haryana mentioned that the proposal conveyed by MoEF&CC, GoI mentioned in the agenda, needs more deliberations.

Decision:

After discussion, the committee agreed and noted that the matter requires further deliberations.

- Agenda Item No. 71/5: Advance Preparatory works regarding Implementation of Upcoming RP-2041.
- 6.1 Committee was apprised about the advance actions initiated by NCRPB regarding Functional Plan(s) preparation through ADB assistance and in-house efforts. It was clarified that the objective was to utilize time in preparatory works and that the finalization of the Functional Plans shall only be after finalization of Regional Plan 2041.
- 6.2 Noting concerns of States regarding working towards respective Sub Regional Plans(SRPs) 2041, it was clarified that SRP can and will only be finalized after the RP 2041 is notified and published, as they are to be in line with Regional Plan and would also require Board consideration before finalization.
- 6.3 Hence States could initiate Tenders/Bids process and float tenders to avoid delays. States could also start process of data collection required for all chapter of SRP including the required geo spatial studies. Bids quotations for all such works, however can be finalized as per the final NCR area of respective sub regions. The same was agreed by the States.

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Decision:

Committee noted the status regarding advance action being taken pertaining to Functional Plans for 2041. It further agreed with the suggestions and after deliberations, following was decided:

- a. Tenders/Bids for SRP 2041 be finalized after Regional Plan finalization, but the tender process may be initiated and tenders floated by States to avoid delays
- b. Collection of data required for all chapter of SRP including the geo spatial studies be initiated by States to avoid delays
- c. Bids quotations will be finalized as per the final NCR area

(Action: NCRPB; NCR States & Cells)

 Agenda Item No. 71/6 A & 71/6 B: Implementation initiatives of States on CRCTA and decisions of Committee of Transport Secretaries/Commissioners (CoTS) meetings including CAQM matter

7.1 Agenda Item No. 71/6 A : Implementation initiatives of States on CRCTA

- 7.1.1 As regard CRCTA, Committee noted the status as provided in the Agenda notes.
- 7.1.2 AS(H&D) suggested that, the impact and assessment of Modal shift from private to public transport if any, and future proposals /projections in this regard could be studied and brought out, under the exercise being /proposed to be undertaken for Transport related Functional Plan. Chairperson suggested that ADB can be requested to look into this aspect, if not already been considered.

(Action: NCRPB)

- 7.2 Agenda Item No. 71/6 B: Matter related to 'Policy to Curb Air Pollution in the National Capital Region' published by Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) in NCR & Adjoining Areas
- 7.2.1 The Committee noted the status and information provided in the Agenda notes. Further, representatives from CAQM informed and updated the members and participants about its latest initiatives and orders to be complied by States and its latest meeting with NCR States on the matter.
- 7.2.2 AS(H&D),MoHUA,GoI and DG, T&CP, Haryana were of the view that CAQM should map its identified 'airshed' on geographical area and display the same on its website, for clarity of decision makers and public at large. Participants were also of the view that definition of 'airshed 'should also be incorporated in the CAQM act and the Act should be applicable on areas covered under 'airshed", instead of NCR. It was also suggested that CAQM officials may make a presentation on the matter in the next meeting.

Decision:

After deliberations, the Committee decided that as the matter is entirely under CAQM domain, it's officials may be requested to make a presentation before the Planning Committee in its next meeting, and till then the agenda item may be deferred.

Agenda Item No.72/3: NCR Planning &Monitoring Cell (NCRP&MC) and Review of Staff status and Work Plans

A. REVIEW OF STAFF STATUS

3.1 Matter was placed before the 40th BM on 31.08.21, the term of NCR cells was extended from 01.04.21 till 30.06.22 and thereafter extension can be considered till 31.03.2025 subject to filling up at least 50% of current vacancies by June 2022.

3.2 Further the matter was placed before the 71st Planning Committee After deliberations, the committee approved the proposal made in the Agenda notes.

- i. Data regarding respective sub regions should be exclusively under control of NCR Cells so that nobody else can tamper with it and data security be ensured by all NCRPMC's.
 - *ii.* Further, Planning Committee recommended Board:
- a. to consider extension for NCR Cells up to June 2023 subject to filling up of 50% vacant posts existing at the time of 40'h Board meeting and thereafter Member Secretary may be authorized/or extension of NCR Cells till 31.03.2025. However, State Government of Haryana has already complied with the directions of the 40th Board meeting regarding filling up of 50% of vacant posts, hence, the extension/or NCR Cell, Haryana is recommended 'in-principle' upto 31.03.2025.
- b. Member Secretary, NCRPB may be authorized to take any administrative and financial decision for smooth and efficient functioning of the NCR P&M Cells in future.

3.3 Thereafter, NCRPB has been taking up the issue in its regular Review Meetings, held on, 24.02.2022, 29-07-2022 (NCT-Delhi), 01.09.2022, 22.09.2022, 22.11.2022, 06.12.2022, 22.11.2022, 06-12-22, 10-1-2023 and on 16-02-2023. The status of vacancies:

3.4 Rajasthan: In the review meeting of the NCR Planning and Monitoring Cells held on 22.11.2022, Chief Town Planner has requested to consider the qualification of GIS Expert and GIS Assistant as communicated vide letter dated 16.11.2021 for the post of Junior Engineer converted to GIS Expert and LDC converted to GIS Assistant, so that the same can be filled up through outsourcing as qualification laid down vide Annexure-II of MoM dated 24.02.2022 is very tough to meet and they are not getting candidates.

Subsequently, NCRPB vide letter 22.02.2023 (Annexure 72/3/I) has requested NCR Cell, Delhi, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh to provide their comments on proposal of Rajasthan regarding the qualification of GIS Expert and GIS Assistant at the earliest. No comments has been received as yet.

Action Point:

Govt. of NCT-Delhi, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh & Rajasthan may apprise the Planning Committee about the action taken for filling up vacant post and their comments on proposal of Rajasthan regarding the qualification of GIS Expert and GIS Assistant

3.5 With regards to dedicated staff utilization certificate, all NCRPMCs have submitted Certificate.

3.6. With regards to submission of Certificate regarding their control on NCR sub-region specific data in their office by NCRPMCs. Rajasthan and UP has submitted the data security certificate. However, Delhi and Haryana may apprise the status.

3.7. The status of Work Programme / Action Plan for FY 2022-23 and 2023-24 and Violation report provided the NCRPMC is as under:

Agenda Item No.72/4: Proposal for additional funding to NCRPB under 50 years interest free loan (to States) scheme of Union Budget 2022-23.

- 4.1 The Hon'ble Union Minister of Finance and Corporate Affairs while presenting the Union Budget in the Parliament on 01.02.2022 for the FY 2022-23 informed about allocation of Rs. 1 lakh cr. to assist the States in catalysing in overall investment in the economy in the form of 50 years interest free loan which is over and above the normal borrowings allowed to the States. Hon'ble Minister stated that this allocation will be used for PM Gati Shakti related and other capital investment of the States. The scheme is further extended by the Hon'ble Finance Minister with a significantly enhanced outlay of Rs.1.3 lakh crore for the FY 2023-24.
- 4.2 The funds under this scheme would be focused for engines like Roads, Railways, Airports, Ports, Mass Transport, Waterways, and Logistics Infrastructure. Further emphasis would be on sectors like Energy Transmission, IT Communication, Bulk Water and Sewerage, and Social Infrastructure.
- 4.3 In order to achieve the vision of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India to develop the Nation as an Atmanirbhar Bharat, a Proposal with Brief Concept Note for special funding line, with initial Rs.5,000 cr. per year, through NCRPB under 50 Years Interest Free Capital Investment Scheme to the National Capital Region has been submitted to the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, GoI on 12.04.2022 for consideration and to be further taken-up with the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, GoI as per due process.

Action Point:

The matter is placed before the Planning Committee for kind information and endorsement by the NCR Participating States.

Agenda Item No. 72/5: Web portal for monitoring the implementation and violations of the Regional Plan for NCR.

- 5.1 NCR Planning and Monitoring Cells (NCR-PMCs) of each sub-region are required to submit the consolidated reports regarding (i) Annual Action Plan, and (ii) violations of the Regional Plan on specified format.
- 5.2 These consolidated reports were required to be submitted on quarterly basis. NCRPB vide its letter dated 04.08.2022 has requested the NCRPMCs that report on Annual Action Plan including cases of violations in each sub-region be submitted on monthly basis instead of quarterly basis.
- 5.3 During discussions on the matter in the 6th meeting of the State Level Steering Committee (SLSC) of Uttar Pradesh Sub-Region, held on 27.01.2023, under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Govt. of U.P., the following has been decided:

- 5.4 Since, the matter related to monitoring the implementation and the violations of the Regional Plan for NCR pertains to all the NCR participating States, therefore, a collective view needs to be taken by all the NCR participating States for creation of the suggested 'Web-Portal'. If agreed, the suggested 'Web-Portal' may be utilized by NCRPMCs for monthly submission of the reports on:
 - i) Annual Action Plan;
 - ii) Implementation of policies and proposals of the Regional Plan/Sub-Regional Plan;
 - iii) Violations of policies and proposals of the Regional Plan on specified format.

Action Point:

Planning Committee may take a view regarding the proposal at para 5.4 above.

Agenda Item 72/6: Delineation of Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ) area in Alwar district of Rajasthan Sub-Region

- 6.1 Govt. of Rajasthan vide letter dated 01.10.2020, 05.10.2020 and 01.01.2021 (Annexure-72/6/I) had conveyed that ground truthing was carried out for the area (59 locations) where variation appeared in NCZ areas of SRP-2021. On the basis of ground truthing report submitted by District Collector, no variation has been found in NCZ area 2237sq.km. as shown in SRP-2021 of Alwar District.
- 6.2 The matter was placed before the 69th Planning Committee held on 23.02.2021 and Committee recommended that matter be placed before the Board for consideration of NCZ area submitted by Govt. of Rajasthan.
- 6.3 Thereafter, the objections raised by RIICO were received through Govt. of Rajasthan vide letter dated 22.07.2022 (Annexure-72/6/II) on the submission made by Govt. of Rajasthan for delineation of NCZ in Alwar and Bharatpur district.
- 6.4 Hence, the recommendation of Planning Committee and the objections raised by RIICO were placed before the Board in its 40th meeting held on 31.08.2021 and informed to the Board that NCRPB vide letter dated 09.08.2021 has requested Govt. of Rajasthan to submit the final recommendation. Accordingly, Board decided that NCZ delineation shall have to be done by December, 2021.
- 6.5 Consequently, after submission made vide letter dated 08.02.2022 and 28.06.2022, Govt. of Rajasthan vide letter dated 01.07.2022 has submitted details of delineation of NCZ in Alwar district as well as Bharatpur district. Also submitted that objection raised by RIICO in respect to NCZ was discussed in 40th Board meeting held on 31.08.2021 and in the meeting held under Chairmanship of Secretary, HUA on 06.09.2021. RIICO has no objection on decision taken in the meeting dated 06.09.2021. In this letter, Govt. of Rajasthan has requested to withdraw the Notice regarding NCZ variation.
- 6.6 Final submission has been made by Govt. of Rajasthan on 22.07.2022 (Annexure-72/6/III) informing the action taken by Govt. of Rajasthan for delineation of NCZ in Alwar district and mentioned earlier submission made vide letter dated 01.01.2021 and 10.02.2021 and requested to withdraw the Notice regarding NCZ.
- 6.7 Further, the matter was discussed in the review meeting held on 06.12.2022 under the chairmanship of Director (A&F). In the meeting, Chairman advised the NCRPMC Rajasthan, should go through the decisions of the Board meetings and the Terms of Reference (ToR) w.r.t. delineation of NCZ. Accordingly, the Agenda item was deferred and decided that matter may be discussed in the next meeting.
- 6.8 In the review meeting held on 10.01.2023, CTP, Rajasthan informed that delineation and ground truthing of NCZ for Rajasthan Sub region (District Alwar) has been done as per the Terms of Reference/ scope of work for NCZ issued by NCRPB in August-2014 by the concerned Departments and Authorities as reported by district Collector, Alwar vide letter 26.09.2020. The same was forwarded by Principal Secretary, UDH vide letter dated

01.10.2020. The same has again been requested by Principal Secretary, UDH vide letter dated 22.07.2022.

6.9 Again the matter has been examined and it has been observed from the file record that Govt. of Rajasthan has not submitted the Report on delineation of NCZ and the maps displaying the demarcated/delineated NCZ boundary as per the decisions of the Board and ToR. It has also been observed that a team of officers was constituted vide Order dated 09.09.2015 by Govt. of Rajasthan and Urban Development and Housing Department has been made the Administrative Department for the team. Further, observed that in the meeting of the said team held on 11.05.2016, sub-team was constituted under the chairmanship of District Collector Alwar. Accordingly, District Collector Alwar had submitted the information to Principal Secretary, UDH, Govt. of Rajasthan. District Collector, Alwar vide letter dated 26.09.2020 has submitted the variation observed in the NCZ area as given in the SRP which was forwarded by Principal Secretary, UDH vide letter dated 01.10.2020 which was placed before the Planning Committee in its 69th meeting and recommended for placing before the Board for consideration.

Minutes of Meeting of Review of NCR Planning & Monitoring Cells

A meeting to review the work of NCR Planning & Monitoring Cells was held at 03.30 PM on 22.11.2022 at office of NCR Planning Board under the Chairpersonship of Member Secretary, NCRPB at New Delhi. Chairperson welcomed the participants to the said meeting. Thereafter, Agenda was then taken up item wise. List of participants is at Annexure-I.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 1: FOLLOW- UP DECISIONS OF 40th BOARD MEETING ON THE CONTINUATION OF NCR PLANNING AND MONITORING CELLS IN NCR PARTICIPATING STATES.

NCT of Delhi

- i. Director (A&F) apprised that as per 40th Board Meeting the extension of all NCRPMCs can be considered till 31.03.2025 subject to filling up of at least 50% of current vacancies by June, 2022.
- ii. Based on the inputs provided by all the NCR Planning & Monitoring Cells (NCRPMC) the data in tabular form was presented to the Chairperson. Director (A&F) while briefing the Chairperson apprised that the NCRPMC of Delhi has filled more than 50% of the vacancies as intimated vide letter dated 15.11.2022.

Rajasthan

- iii. CTP, Rajasthan has informed that out of 5 vacant posts, 2 posts (Investigator Gr.I ad UDC/Sr. Assistant) have been filed up, however for the remaining post request has been sent to Finance Department. CTP requested to issue Sanction Orders for the post as being asked by Finance Department.
- iv. NCRPMC Rajasthan has requested vide letter dated 14.11.2022 to consider the qualification of GIS Expert and GIS Assistant as communicated vide letter dated 16.11.2021 for the post of Junior Engineer converted to GIS Expert and LDC converted to GIS Assistant, so that the same can be filled up through outsourcing as qualification laid down vide Annexure-II of MoM dated 24.02.2022 is very tough to meet and they are not getting candidates. It was not clarified why these requests being put up after delay of about 9 months from February 2022; NCRPMC, Rajasthan was asked to explain reasons for delay along with timely efforts if taken, to fill the vacancies.
- v. It was also decided that the matter of qualification be put up to the Competent Authority after taking inputs from concerned officers of NCRPB.

Haryana

- vi. In the matter of NCRPMC of Haryana, the Chairperson, advised CCP to fill up the newly created vacancies as for preparation of SRP they would require ATPs, GIS professionals and other staff strength to work on it. Chairperson also advised that the data security system be enhanced and that practice of staff sharing between Cell and T&CP is not acceptable and should be replaced with full time staff for Cell.
- vii. CCP informed that the Cell is bound to hire staff from Rozgar Kaushal Nigam of State Government in cases where the remuneration / salary is below Rs. 30,000 per month. In cases where the salary is more than Rs. 30,000 per month, the hiring can be carried out through other agencies.

Sub.: Regarding Notice issued to Rajasthan on Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ).

Ref:- Your letter No.K-14048/2/2020-NCRPB (39th) dated 04.12.2020.

Madam,

With reference to the above mention notice issued to Rajasthan on Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ). In point no. 8.4 of the Agenda Item no. 8 of minutes of meeting of 39th Board Meeting, the board has directed to submit final details and replies with in the next one month to the board for consideration in the next Board meeting.

In this regard, it is to inform that the Ground Truthing report from District Collector Alwar and a note on NCZ area in Sub-Regional Plan-2021 of Alwar District has been sent to NCRPB vide letter dated 01.10.2020 and 05.10.2020 respectively as required by NCRPB on the basis of following exercise done.

- With reference to above, NCZ area shown in Sub-Regional Plan -2021, Alwar was superimposed on the satellite imagery of 2012 (provided by NSRC, Hyderabad) by this office. The area under 59 locations, where variation appeared in NCZ areas of Sub-Regional Plan-2021, Alwar & Satellite Imagery-2012, were demarcated and maps with GPS Coordinates prepared for these areas.
- Ground Truthing of identified areas of Natural conservation Zone in Sub Regional plan -2021 of district Alwar has been done by concernd departments and authorites as reported by District Collector Alwar vide letter dated

26.09.2020. According to the NCZ ground truthing report, no variation has been found in NCZ area from Existing landuse -1999.

Earlier, status Report on NCRPB letter dated 23.06.2014 was sought by the NCRPB, in which variation was observed. This office examined the same and following status report has been prepared.

- The notice Dated 23.06.2014 under Section 29(2) of NCR Planning Board Act,1985 has been received, in which tentative locations of places where variations in NCZ has been mentioned in table-02 of the said Notice. Total 138 locations were identified after analysis carried out by the NCRPB Secretariat, in consulation with National Remote Sensing Center (NRSC), Govt of India using Satellite Imagery, which indicates variations in the NCZ as contained in the Regional Plan-2021, notified in 2005 as compared to the landuse as analysed in 2012.
- In reference to notice dated 23.06.2014, This office could identify only 87 locations on google earth out of 138 location as given and following analysis has been made with superimposition on the layers of landuse Plan-2005 & 2012:-
 - Total 66 locations (Annexure -' A') out of 87 location lye in Agriculture (Rural) Zone, These are out of NCZ area.
 - Total 12 locations (Annexure -'B') lye in NCZ only in landuse map 2012, which is not shown as NCZ in landuse map-2005. Hence no NCZ variation has been found in these 12 locations.
 - Total 09 locations (Annexure -'C') are found in NCZ in both layers of landuse map-2005 as well as landuse map-2012, So there is no variation in that also.
 - Remaining 52 locations (Annexure -'D') could not be identified on google earth by searching with their name without coordinates.

In the absence of coordinates, it is not possible to demarcate the locations exactly as mentioned in letter dated 23.06.2014. Moreover, only 87 locations out of 138 are traceable on the basis of name. Therefore, it is requested to send coordinates of the locations mentioned in letter dated 23.06.2014 so that exact analysis may be done.

However, on the basis of examination done at this office only at 59 locations, variation appeared in NCZ areas of Sub-Regional Plan-2021, Alwar & Satellite Imagery-2012, which were demarcated and maps with GPS Coordinates prepared for these areas and Ground Truthing has been done by the concern departments. No variation is found in NCZ area 2237 sq. km shown in SRP-2021(Alwar district), which has been reported to NCRPB vide this office letter dated 01.10.2020 and 05.10.2020.

Therefore it is requested to kindly withdraw the notice regarding NCZ.

In reference to above cited letter, following are the comments & suggestions on draft proposed Regional Plan-2041:

1. Proposed Provision: In draft Regional Plan-2041, the Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ) as provided and detailed out by NCR State Governments for the Regional Plan-2021 is proposed to be continued.

Suggestion: The land marked as Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ) in Regional Plan NCR-2021 & subsequent Regional Plan NCR -2041, which is prepared to be extended till RP-2041 is based only on satellite imagery.

RIICO has raised objection based on the revenue record and suggested identified 2600 hect of Government land (revised lands details are enclosed herewith) to be deleted from NCZ areas.

Looking at the new developments of Delhi-Baroda National Highway and scarcity of industrial land in Rajasthan sub-region of NCR, RIICO has identified about 2600 hect. of govt lands in Alwar&Bharatpur districts. These Identified lands are essential for industrialization in Rajasthan State as due to following reasons:

- No other alternative government land is available in National Capital Region; (i)
- These chunks are suitable for industrial areas; (ii)
- There is continuous demand of land for manufacturing and service industries; (iii)
- (iv) To implement the DMIC project in KBNIR, availability of government land is necessarily required;
- To provide industrial land on cheaper rates to compete with neighbor states. (v)
- Due to proximity to Delhi and Gurgaon, there is huge potential in these areas; (vi)

These identified lands are falling in Natural Conservation Zone as per NCR Regional Plan-2021 and also same in Sub-Regional Plan for Rajasthan Sub-Region-2021 (Alwar) & Sub-Regional Plan for Extended Rajasthan Sub-Region of NCR-2021 (Bharatpur).

Due to above cited reasons, identified lands may be deleted from Natural Conservation Zone provided in the RP-2021/2041 and existing Sub-Regional Plan for Rajasthan Sub-Region-2021 (Alwar) & Sub-Regional Plan for Extended Rajasthan Sub-Region of NCR-2021 (Bharatpur) and subsequent Rajasthan sub-region plan.

 Proposed Provision: In Regional Plan NCR 2021, to prevent unplanned development along major transport corridors, and to harness the development potential of these connectivity alignments, Highway Corridor Zone (HCZ) were proposed in the past plans to enable the planned development in minimum 500 metres on both side of the highways.

Now in draft Regional Plan NCR-2041, it is proposed that intense development will be encouraged on both sides of all the rail transit corridors, expressways, NHs and their transit nodes in an area up to <u>01 kms on either side of the highways / expressways</u> starting from edge of highway or up to the outer boundary of intervening revenue villages, whichever is earlier. These Transit oriented development (TOD) corridors shall have dense residential, office, institutional, commercial among other spaces which generally require trunk transport facilities.

<u>Suggestion</u>: Rail corridors, Highways/expressways provide leverage to the Industrial development, therefore industrial development may also be encouraged on both sides of all the rail transit corridors, expressways, NHs and their transit nodes in an area up to 02 kms (inplace of 1 km) on either side of the highways / expressways starting from edge of highway or up to the outer boundary of intervening revenue villages, whichever is earlier.

It is requested to incorporate above suggestions in the Regional Plan NCR-2021/2041 and existing Sub-Regional Plan for Rajasthan Sub-Region-2021 (Alwar) & Sub-Regional Plan for Extended Rajasthan Sub-Region of NCR-2021 (Bharatpur) and subsequent Rajasthan sub-region plan.

उपरोक्त विषयान्तर्गत लेख है कि राजस्थान सब रीजन (जिला अलवर) के एनसीजेड (प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन) में आने वाले भू–भाग के चिन्हिकरण एवं मौके के पुष्टीकरण के सबंधं में सन्दर्भित पत्र में आप द्वारा चाहे गये वांछित स्पष्टीकरण बिन्दुवार निम्नानुसार है :–

- एनसीआर प्लानिंग बोर्ड, नई दिल्ली के द्वारा एनसीजेड के संबंध में एनसीआरपीबी एक्ट 1985 की धारा 29(2) के अन्तर्गत जारी नोटिस दिनांक : 23.06.2014 प्राप्त हुआ था। जिसमें एनसीजेड क्षेत्र में विचलन वाले संभावित भू–भागों के नाम उक्त नोटिस की सारणी संख्या 02 में उल्लेखित थे। एनसीआरपीबी द्वारा राष्ट्रीय सुदूर संवेदन केन्द्र (एनआरएससी), हैदराबाद से परामर्श पश्चात् सेटेलाईट इमेजरी जो कि रीजनल प्लान – 2021 (वर्ष 2005 में अनुमोदित) एवं वर्ष 2012 की सेटेलाईट इमेजरी के आंकलन के माध्यम से 138 संभावित(Tentative) भू–भागों (केवल सूची) की पहचान एनआरएससी, हैदराबाद के द्वारा की गयी, जहॉ एनसीआरपीबी के नोटिस अनुसार विचलन पाया गया।
- 2. उक्त नोटिस दिनांक 23.06.2014 के क्रम में एनसीआरपीबी द्वारा प्रेषित 138 स्थलों की सूची (बिना कोर्डिनेटस के) में से केवल 87 भू–भागों की पहचान नाम के आधार पर गूगल अर्थ पर हो पाई है तथा इन 87 स्थलों हेतु भू–उपयोग मानचित्र 2005 एवं 2012 की लेयरों को आरोपित कर निम्नाकिंत निष्कर्ष पाया गया।
 - कुल 87 भू—भागों में से 66 भू—भाग कृषि (ग्रामीण) क्षेत्र में पाये गये। जो कि प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन क्षेत्र से बाहर है।
 - कुल 12 भू—भागों जो कि भू—उपयोग मानचित्र 2012 में प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन में दर्शाये गये है, जो कि भू—उपयोग मानचित्र 2005 में प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन में दर्शित नहीं थे। अतः इन 12 भू—भागों हेतु प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन में कोई विचलन नहीं पाया गया।
 - कुल 09 भू—भागों जो कि भू—उपयोग मानचित्र 2005 एवं 2012 दोनो की लेयर में प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन में पाये गये है। अतः इनके कोई विचलन नहीं पाया गया।
 - 138 स्थलों की सूची में से शेष रहे 52 भू—भागों को जो कि एनसीआरपीबी द्वारा प्रेषित की गयी सूची में बिना कोर्डिनेटस के थे, को गूगल अर्थ पर नाम के आधार पर खोजने पर नहीं पाये गये।

अतः शेष 52 भू—भागों की पहचान कोर्डिनेटस के बिना किया जाना संभव नहीं हो पाने एवं नाम के आधार पर खोजने पर 138 में से केवल 87 भू—भागों स्थिति ही मिल पाई है। जिसके क्रम में इस कार्यालय के पत्र दिनांक 01.01.2021 द्वारा इन भू—भागों की कोर्डिनेटस चाही गयी थी। जो कि आज दिनांक तक इस कार्यालय को अप्राप्त है। 69 वीं प्लानिंग कमेटी की बैठक दिनांक 23.02.2021 के कार्यवाही विवरण के एजेण्डा संख्या 4.3 में भी उक्तानुसार इन भू—भागों के कोर्डिनेट्स एनसीआरपीबी द्वारा उपलब्ध करवाये जाने में असमर्थता बताई गई थी।

यद्यपि, उक्त कार्य को संपादित करने के क्रम में कार्यालय मुख्य नगर नियोजक (एनसीआर) एवं क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय अलवर द्वारा एनआरएससी, हैदराबाद द्वारा वर्ष 2012 के सेटेलाईट इमेजरी से तैयार जीआईएस फाईल में सीमाओं ⁄ एनसीजेड क्षेत्र के अन्तर्गत भू–भाग को राजस्थान सब रीजन (जिला अलवर) के Landuse Plan Level-II के जीआईएस फाईल पर सुपरइम्पोज करवाया जाकर प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन के अन्तर्गत आने वाले भू–भाग में ऐसे क्षेत्र जहॉ दोनो सीमाओं में अन्तर आ रहा है, उन क्षेत्रो ⁄ भू–भाग को चिन्हित कर एवं उन क्षेत्रो के GPS Coordinates आदि सूचनाऐ संकलित कर मानचित्र तैयार किये गये थे। उक्तानुसार की गयी जाँच के अनुसार सब रीजनल प्लान – 2021, अलवर की 59 भू–भागों पर एनसीजेड में विचलन होना पाया गया, जिसे मानचित्र पर कोर्डिनेटस के अनुसार चिन्हित कर सम्बन्धित विभाग से ग्राउन्ड ट्रूथिंग एवं पुष्टीकरण करवाया गया। जिसके अनुसार भी प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन में कोई विचलन नही पाया गया। इस हेतु पूर्व में भी इस कार्यालय के पत्र दिनांक 01.01.2021 व 10.02.2021 के द्वारा अवगत करवाया जा चुका है।

उल्लेखनीय है कि, इस कार्यालय द्वारा प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन के पुष्टिकरण हेतु विश्लेषण एनसीआरपीबी के नोटिस, दिनांक – 23.06.2014 में उल्लेखित 138 संभावित भू–भागों के आधार पर न किया जाकर (कोर्डिनेटस के अभाव में जो एनसीआरपीबी से इस कार्यालय को आज दिनांक तक प्राप्त नहीं हुऐ) उक्त कार्य को इस कार्यालय स्तर से ही उपरोक्तानुसार सुपरइम्पोज करवाया जाकर किया गया था।

अतः उपरोक्त विश्लेषण से स्पष्ट है कि सब रीजनल प्लान – 2021, अलवर में दर्शित सम्पूर्ण प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन जिसका कुल क्षेत्रफल 2237 वर्ग किलोमीटर हैं, मे कोई भी विचलन नहीं पाया गया है। इस हेतु पूर्व में भी कई बार एनसीआरपीबी को सूचित किया जा चुका है।

उक्त प्रेषित तथ्यों के क्रम में प्राकृतिक संरक्षण जोन से सम्बन्धित नोटिस को निरस्त करवाये जाने का श्रम करावें।

F. It is also submitted that, Bharatpur district was added later in NCR area vide notification dated 01.10.2013 and was not the part of the Regional Plan 2021 notified on 17.09.2015. Draft Sub-Regional Plan of district Bharatpur was considered by the Board in its 38th Board meeting held on 13.09.2019 and same was notified by Govt. of Rajasthan on 18.02.2020. Total area of District Bharatpur is 5066.81 Sq.km., Out of which approximately 742.84 sq.km area is identified under Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ). It has been discussed and agreed by the Board in its 41stmeeting dated 12.10.2021, that no NCZ violation notice has been issued for newly added district Bharatpur. Hence, further action for NCZ of district Bharatpur will be taken up in SRP-2041 under conformity of policies & proposals of RP-2041.

In view of above facts, all the required information has been submitted regarding NCZ for district Alwar.

Natural conservation Zone in Regional Plan-2021 was shown tentatively, accordingly NCZ area has detailed out in Sub-Regional Plan-2021 of Alwar district. Therefore, ground truthing has been done for NCZ area. On the basis of ground truthing, no variation has been found in Natural Conservation Zone area 2237 sq.km. as shown in SRP-2021 of Alwar District.

Therefore, it is again requested to kindly withdraw the notice regarding NCZ variation.

It was decided that the status of delineation of NCZ and ground truthing will be placed before the Board in its next meeting.

iii. Agenda 4.3 Govt. of Rajasthan

CTP, Rajasthan stated that after doing the exercise no variation has been found in the NCZ area. He further mentioned that SRP 2021 of Alwar district has more NCZ area (2237 sqkm) than RP 2021 (1285.46 sqkm) and requested to drop the notice issued on this matter. As per the District Collector, Alwar report stated that there is no variation. Further, coordinates of some locations had been sought from NCRPB which the concerned officer has clarified that we are unable to supply due to various reasons.

Committee recommended that matter be placed before the Board for consideration of the NCZ area submitted by Govt. of Rajasthan

iv. Chairperson also requested the Members for their views for delineation of NCZ in the newly added districts in NCR. CTP Rajasthan informed that there is only one new district (Bharatpur) has been added and suggested that delineation and ground truthing of the NCZ area should be left to the respective States. CCP, Haryana stated that Haryana views can only be offered after discussing the matter with the Principal Secretary, T&CP Department. She however informed that no exercise has been initiated on delineation of NCZ for the newly added districts of Haryana Sub Region in NCR. CCP, NCR Cell UP, informed that ground truthing with revenue record is not done in the additional areas of U.P. sub-region.

After deliberations, it was decided that all the NCR States may send their views on requirement of delineation and ground truthing of the NCZ in additional areas in writing to NCRPB.

8. AGENDA ITEM NO. 5: CONTINUATION OF NCR PLANNING AND MONITORING CELLS (NCRP&M Cells) IN NCR PARTICIPATING STATES

- i. Director (A&F) informed that a meeting was held on 19.02.2021 in this matter, wherein NCR Cells were asked to submit their outcomes on the Work Programme/Action Plan during 2017-2021 and efforts made by them to fill the vacancies. Cells were requested to submit a proposal for further course of action with details w.r.t. problems faced in filling up of vacancies.
- ii. Special Secretary, GNCT Delhi informed that matter had been taken up with the government and is pending, and department has no planners. - Ground Truthing of identified areas of Natural conservation Zone in Sub Regional plan -2021 of district Alwar has been done by concernd departments and authorites as reported by District Collector Alwar vide letter dated

26.09.2020. According to the NCZ ground truthing report, no variation has been found in NCZ area from Existing landuse -1999.

Earlier, status Report on NCRPB letter dated 23.06.2014 was sought by the NCRPB, in which variation was observed. This office examined the same and following status report has been prepared.

- The notice Dated 23.06.2014 under Section 29(2) of NCR Planning Board Act,1985 has been received, in which tentative locations of places where variations in NCZ has been mentioned in table-02 of the said Notice. Total 138 locations were identified after analysis carried out by the NCRPB Secretariat, in consulation with National Remote Sensing Center (NRSC), Govt of India using Satellite Imagery, which indicates variations in the NCZ as contained in the Regional Plan-2021, notified in 2005 as compared to the landuse as analysed in 2012.

 - Total 12 locations (Annexure -'B') lye in NCZ only in landuse map 2012, which is not shown as NCZ in landuse map-2005. Hence no NCZ variation has been found in these 12 locations.
 - Total 09 locations (Annexure -'C') are found in NCZ in both layers of landuse map-2005 as well as landuse map-2012, So there is no variation in that also.
 - Remaining 52 locations (Annexure -'D') could not be identified on google earth by searching with their name without coordinates.

In the absence of coordinates, it is not possible to demarcate the locations exactly as mentioned in letter dated 23.06.2014. Moreover, only 87 locations out of 138 are traceable on the basis of name. Therefore, it is requested to send coordinates of the locations mentioned in letter dated 23.06.2014 so that exact analysis may be done.

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However, on the basis of examination done at this office only at 59 locations, variation appeared in NCZ areas of Sub-Regional Plan-2021, Alwar & Satellite Imagery-2012, which were demarcated and maps with GPS Coordinates prepared for these areas and Ground Truthing has been done by the concern departments. Supplementary Agenda Item No. 72/01: Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ) delineation work for Delhi and its request for reimbursement of related costs, by NCR Planning Board

Background

- 1.1 The Board in its Special Meeting held on 25.04.2014 while considering the Draft Sub Regional Plan for Haryana Sub-Region of NCR-2021, decided that Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ) in NCR be delineated by each participating State based on detailed ground truthing, along with verification of State revenue records. Thereafter, the SRPs would stand amended.
- 1.2 Since certain variations were noticed in NCZ and reasons for variations were not submitted by the NCR participating States, NCRPB issued Notice(s) dated 23.06.2014 under Section 29(2) of NCRPB Act, 1985 regarding variations in NCZ and requested the State Govts. to take appropriate steps in this regard and submit a detailed reply in a time bound manner.
- 1.3 In this regard, it is submitted that as per the TOR for Delineation of NCZ finalised in August 2014, work was to be undertaken and completed by respective NCR participating state and teams were constituted to get the work done. It has is no such provision indicating that NCRPB shall make the payment or reimburse the expenditure done for the work.
- 1.4 Based on status provided and actions taken by NCR states in the 39th Board Meeting held on 05.10.2022, while Notice w.r.t Uttar Pradesh was withdrawn, the matter was still pending for Haryana, Rajasthan and Delhi.
- 1.5 While the NCZ delineation status for Rajasthan Sub region is as discussed at Agenda 72/6, the work is still to be finalised for Haryana and Delhi.
- 1.6 With respect to Delhi, the 40th Board meeting (31.08.21) had considered draft SRP 2021 for Delhi, mentioning that published SRP shall stand amended after delineation of NCZ by GNCT of Delhi.
- 1.7 The SRP 2021 for Delhi was finalised by GNCT of Delhi in November 2021 with NCZ. Natural Conservation Zone (NCZ) is part of Sub-Regional Plan (SRP) prepared by the participating States of NCR. This NCZ policies and proposals are at section 12.9.2 and is elaborated in chapter on Sub Regional Land Use in chapter 14 and demarcated on the map of Proposed Land Use.
- 1.8 However NCZ delineation work with ground truthing, along with verification of State revenue records, as mandated vide ToRs for the purpose, was still on, and SRPs were to be amended as per delineation arrived at by GNCT of Delhi after ground truthing exercise.
- 1.9 SRP Delhi for 2021 was informed to have been prepared at cost of Rs. 23 lakh plus taxes, bills of which are still to be received for reimbursing the payments made. NCRPB is reimbursing cost of expenditure incurred in Sub Regional Plan preparation as per decision of Board in its 33rd Board meeting (01.07.2013).

Matter for consideration

- 1.10 UD Department Delhi and DDA have been taking necessary action w.r.t NCZ delineation works of Delhi. UD Dept. GNCT of Delhi, vide its letter dated 31.01.2023 has requested NCRPB to make payment to GSDL on account of delivery of maps containing details of 154 NCZ polygons in Delhi, or reimburse the said amount to UD Department, GNCT of Delhi. The partial bill for part work undertaken for NCZ delineation is informed to be around Rs. 36.28 lakhs.
- 1.11 As per the TOR for Delineation of NCZ (based on ground trothing and verification with revenue records) finalised in August 2014, and its subsequent clarifications, work was to be

undertaken and completed by respective NCR participating state and teams were constituted to get the work done. It had no provision indicating that NCRPB shall make the payment or reimburse the expenditure done for the Delineation of NCZ.

Action Point:

- i. Agenda item placed before Planning Committee for discussion and decision
- *ii.* A view needs to be taken whether the NCRPB can reimburse the expenditure incurred by NCT Delhi, to comply with decision of the Board and to submit detailed reply sought against Notice issued by Board, under Section 29(2) of NCRPB Act, 1985.

Supplementary Agenda Item No. 72/02: To discuss the recovery of Commitment Charges due to delay/ non-drawal of loan in projects being funded under the ADB and KfW line of credit.

- 2.1 NCRPB has funded various infrastructure projects under ADB and KfW line of credit. Under these lines of credit the disbursement of loan were based on reimbursement basis as per ADB/KfW loan agreements with applicability of commitment charges on account of delay in drawal of loan.
- 2.2 The same condition was included in the loan agreement with the Borrowing/Implementing Agencies (as per Annexure-I) stating "in case of delay in project implementation as per the stipulated time schedule/drawl of loan instalments/withdrawal of project from NCRPB Funding, the borrowing agency will be liable to reimburse the commitment charges to NCRPB as levied by ADB / KfW".
- 2.3 NCRPB had drawn the loan from ADB/KfW based on requests for loan received from the Borrowing/Implementing Agencies. Therefore, NCRPB has paid the commitment charges to ADB/KfW as per the embedded condition/provision of their loan agreements.
- 2.4 As per the loan drawal schedule of the relevant loan sanctions in respect of projects where such condition was included, Commitment Charges for Rs. 2.12 Crore & Rs. 0.93 Crore are due from NCRPB's Borrowing Agencies on account of delay in drawal and non-drawal of loan instalments respectively upto the date of commitment charges paid by NCRPB i.e. 23.12.2014 for ADB and 31.12.2018 for KfW, as under:
